JUST IN CASE YOU MISSED HER

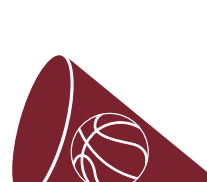

Youth Sports Program



BTCS kicked off its new elementary youth sports program this fall with more than 650 students participating in basketball and cheerleading in grades K through 5. The program currently includes 40 basketball teams and 14 cheerleading teams with 55 volunteer coaches. Games will begin in January. K-1 games will be at Fairmount on Saturdays; 2-3 will be at Fairmount and Avoca on Tuesday and Thursday nights; 4-5 games will be at Anderson and Haynesfield on Tuesday and Thursday nights. The youth sports program will offer soccer and track to students in the spring.

"I am extremely excited about the start of this program," said Jennifer Testa, BTCS youth sports coordinator. "I think the overall numbers for a new program show just how important this is for our community, and I hope each and every year we can build on this excitement and make it the best experience possible for our kids. Coach Dale Burns, who passed away earlier this year, worked hard to get this program started and was passionate about providing this opportunity for kids in our community. His love and desire to serve our youth continues to inspire me through this program as it has throughout my coaching career."

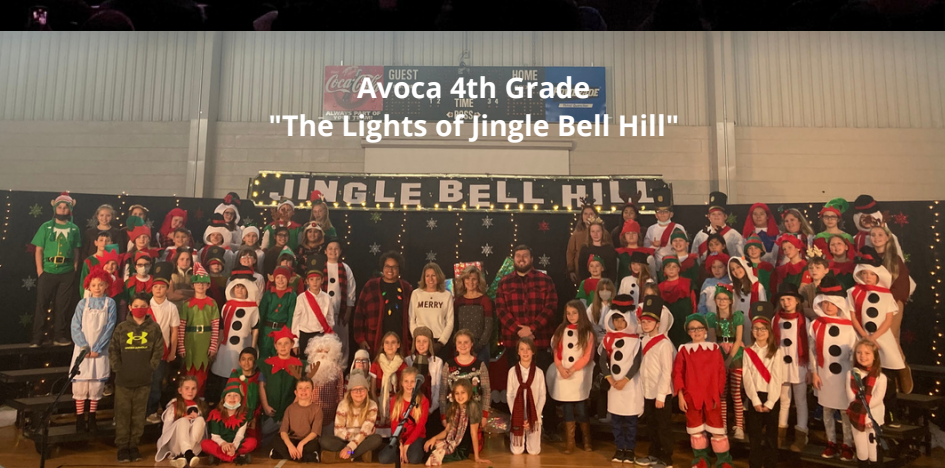

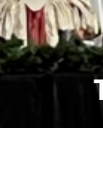

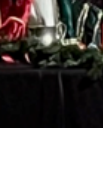
